

# 9th "Nilo Peraldo Bert" International Award Biella (BI) June 7th-8th, 2024

#### **RULES**

#### Art. 1 Competition enrollment

The competition is open to all musicians of all nationalities and will be taking place at Accademia "Lorenzo Perosi" - Corso del Piazzo, 24 - Biella (BI) Italy - on June 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

# Art. 2 Sections and categories

All rounds will be open to the public. Sections and categories will be arranged as following:

• Solo competition (Guitar)

June 8th, 2024

Cat. A classical guitar, born from 2012 (born in 2012, 2013, 2014 and so on)

Cat. B classical guitar, born from 2008 to 2011

Cat. C classical guitar, born from 2004 to 2007

June 7th, 2024 (Eliminatory Round)

June 8th, 2024 (Final Round)

Cat. D "Performers", classical guitar, up to 40 years old

• Chamber music competition (from 2 to 8 musicians) with at least one guitar or mandolin June 8th, 2024

Cat. E average age under 18

June 7th, 2024 (Eliminatory Round)

June 8th, 2024 (Final Round)

Cat. F "Chamber Music Prize" no age limit

It is possibile to enroll in higher categories. It is not possible to enroll in two different categories in the Solo competition. Neither the outright winners of a previous edition in solo competition nor first prize winning groups in the chamber music competition can enroll with the same ensemble or for the same category. Special prizes can not be assigned to the same musician in the same category more than once.

#### **Art. 6 Scores**

The point system is expressed in cents. Participants with a score not less than 95/100 will be assigned the 1st prize. Participants with a score not less than 90/100 will be assigned the 2nd prize. Participants with a score not less than 85/100 will be assigned the 3rd prize. The outright winner for each section will be the participant with the highest score within first prizes. The decision of the Jury is not subject to appeal. Results will be announced at the end of the eliminatory round for D and F categories. Final results will be announced during the award giving ceremony.

Outright winners prizes in each category so as first prizes in D and F categories cannot be shared. First, second and third prizes could be assigned to one or more participant at the Jury's discretion. No more than eight (8) performances (without distinction between soloists and chamber groups) will be admitted to the Final round.

Prizes may not be awarded at the Jury's discretion.

The award giving ceremonies will take place on **June 8th**, **2024 starting from 6.00 p.m.** at Accademia "Perosi" (BI). Prize winner must be present at the ceremony: failing to do so will result in the loss of the prize.

The competition will take place, for each category, only if the numbers of participants allows a meaningful competition.

#### Art. 9 Auditions

Prior to the audition all participants will have to submit to the Jury a copy of the scores of their program and an ID card or passport. The auditions' schedule, the time and the location of the roll call will be on-line starting from May 31st, 2024. The Jury is allowed to stop the performance in case it will exceed the time limit. Those members of the Jury who have family relationship or ongoing teaching relationships with participants must declare it and will be abstained from judging them.

The Artistic Direction may reserve the right to modify the timetables of the auditions, due to force majeure. Participants will receive timely communication around the updates.
